To Make				
 Write "Hip, Hip, Hooray" on a sentence strip. Attach corresponding image. Create new Unit Chart: "Words We Are Learning." 	 Create a Dr. Elsie puppet by attaching her image (laminated if possible) to a craft stick. Create the Letter Ring: write the uppercase <i>letter T</i> on one side of an index card and the lowercase <i>letter t</i> on the other. Attach to binder ring. 	 Add 2-5 black dots on each paper plate in new arrangements. Create the Unit Chart: "Turn and Talk." On two sentence strips, write: "knee to knee" and "eye to eye."
