You might ask some of the following questions to help generate ideas and jot down what your child says. Send this information back to school in order to help your child be prepared to share, draw and/or write about this topic.

- What farm animal do you know a lot about?
- What do you know about this animal?
- What does it look like?
- How does it move?
- What sounds does it make?
- What does it do all day?

If your child shares some ideas with you that you think are factually inaccurate, honor their thinking. You can always use their ideas as a springboard for learning more about the topic together.
