We are creating a class book called *Learning About Mixing* in which children describe what they have learned about mixing. In school, we have talked about how mixtures are everywhere! Some mixtures can be separated and some cannot. Some things change when you mix them together (like flour and water) and some do not (like red blocks and blue blocks). To support this work, please talk with your child about what they know about mixing. You might ask some of the following questions to help generate ideas. Please jot down what your child says and send this information back to school. This will help them be prepared to share.

- When do we make mixtures at home?
- What are some things you have mixed together in school?
- What happened when you mixed those things together?
- What else have you mixed together?
- What tools have you used to mix things together?
- What are you learning about mixing?
