Let's Eat!

Dear Families,

Children learned a new card game in school called "Who Has More?" This game gives them practice identifying and comparing numbers (or numerals like 1 or 2). Playing games gives children a chance to practice skills in a fun, interactive way. Ask your child about the game "Who Has More?" You can play at home too.

Object of the Game:

Be the first player to collect all cards.

Directions:

- Use a deck of playing cards. Deal five cards to each player.
- Each player flips over a card at the same time. Whoever has the higher number collects the cards.
- The game ends when one player collects all the cards.

Tips

- Ask your child how they know which number is higher. Talking about math is just as important as doing math!
- What if both players flip the same number? Ask your child what to do.
- What if your child doesn't know a numeral? Show the number with your fingers and count together.



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
