<b>Special Materials</b>

<b>To Make</b>				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Using brown or gray construction paper, create ten paper "stones." Label each one with a numeral from one to ten. These should be big enough for a child to stand on. Tape them to the ground in order so they look like a number line. Leave some space so children can jump between them. Create 2-3 sets.</li> <li>• Create a separate starting point stone. Label it with an "X."</li> <li>• Create 2-4 sets of plus cards using index cards. Write +1, +2, +3 on several of them and shuffle.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create 2-4 sets of minus cards using index cards. Write -1, -2, -3 on several of them and shuffle with the plus cards.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create 2-4 zero cards. Write the numeral 0 on index cards and shuffle with plus and minus cards.</li> </ul>
