Dear Families,

We are creating a classroom informational book called *We Know the Sky* in which children can share facts they know about what is in the sky. To support this work, observe the sky with your child and talk about what they see. You might ask some of the following questions to help generate ideas and jot down what your child says. Send this information back to school in order to help your child be prepared to share, draw and/or write about this topic.

- •What do you see in the sky?
- •What is your favorite thing in the sky?
- What does it look like? Does it change? Why is it in the sky?
- •What other questions do you have about it?

If your child shares some ideas with you that you think are factually inaccurate, honor their thinking. You can always use their ideas as a springboard for learning more about the topic together.
