Create a Bear puppet by drawing a picture of Bear (laminate if possible) and attach it to a craft stick. Create a new Unit Chart: "Words We Are Learning." 	 Attach STOP sign image (printed in color or colored in red, laminated if possible) to a craft stick. Create a simple drawing of Bear on a sticky note. Cut out shapes of varying sizes. 	 Write the uppercase letter N on one side of an index card and the lowercase letter n on the other. Create the Unit Chart: "Ways to Say Hello."
