

What kind of tree can you carry in your hand?

Riddles! In school we use riddles to laugh, build vocabulary, and review information children have been learning.

For example, we have been reviewing animals and their homes using riddles. Here is one riddle we shared. Ask your child what the answer is!

This animal makes a nest in trees.

It leaps from tree branch to tree branch.

It has a furry tail.

What is it?

Create riddles at home, too!

Look around the room and focus on an object. Say some clues (e.g., shape, size, color, function). Invite your child to solve your riddle! Encourage your child to tell you clues for a new riddle that you can solve. Remind your child that clues are information you say without telling the name of the object.

You can play this game just about anywhere - while eating together, shopping together, on a walk or on the bus, or even before bedtime!
